



Arts Grants Awarded in Clearwater County

Region 2 Arts Council (R2AC) awarded \$27,747 to arts organizations, schools, and non-profits in Clearwater county in FY2017.

Bagley Area Arts Collaborative was awarded a \$6,000 Arts and Cultural Heritage Grant to host a series of musical storytelling presentations and educational concerts that examine the roots and styles of music as well as pivotal historical events.

Farm by the Lake, Bagley, received a \$2,420 Arts Project Grant to host a presentation of six storytellers including Loren Niemi, Richard Rousseau, Beverly Cottman, Ann Dunn, Steve Maanum, and Sonja Kosler, culminating in a workshop by Jamie Lee on how audience members can assemble stories from there own lives.

Clearwaters Life Center was awarded a \$6,000 Arts and Cultural Heritage Grant for Small Towns to produce their Wildwood Concert Series *Imagine it!*

Bagley Public Schools received a \$2,753 Arts and Cultural Heritage Grant for Small Towns to bring in Prairie Fire Children's Theater to produce *Sleeping Beauty*.

Farm by the Lake, Bagley, received a \$6,000 Arts and Cultural Heritage Grant for Small Towns to produce their Summer Concert Series.

Clearbrook-Gonvick Community Education was awarded a \$2,595 Arts and Cultural Heritage Grant for Small Towns to bring in Prairie Fire Children's Theater to produce *Pinocchio*.

Church Basement Rosemalers, Shevlin, received a \$2,150 Arts and Cultural Heritage Grant to hire Ruth Green, a Gold Medalist Rosemaler from Decorah, Iowa, to hold a three-day workshop on American Rogaland Rosemaling in June, 2017.

Bagley Area Arts Collaborative was awarded a \$1,829 Arts Project Grant to host a three-day *plein air* workshop with Arna Rennan that will focus on painting landscapes while enjoying the outdoors.
