



Arts Grants Awarded in Clearwater County

Region 2 Arts Council (R2AC) awarded \$25,514 to arts organizations, schools, non-profits, and individual artists in Clearwater County in FY 2018.

Tawnee Corning received \$1,446 to purchase supplies to create a series of seven oil paintings for exhibition on the topic of existential psychoanalysis. (Clearwater County).

Bagley Area Arts Collaborative received a \$5,625 Arts Access Grant for “Arts Unlimited” – a series of new art workshops for 2018.

Clearbrook- Gonvick Elementary received a \$3,705 Arts Access Grant for students in grades 3 - 6 to see a concert at the Ordway Center for the Arts and visit nearby art museums.

Clearbrook Gonvick Public Schools received a \$6,000 Arts Access Grant to bring Copper Street Brass to their school for an arts residency and community concert.

Clearbrook-Gonvick Community Education was awarded a \$1,189 Arts Access Grant to bring Prairie Fire Children’s Theater to direct the play *Tom Sawyer*, for local performers from age seven to adult, as part of their Summer Recreation program. June 22 & 23, 2018.

Bagley Area Arts Collaborative received a \$1,549 Arts Access Grant to host a Plein Air Painting workshop with Dan Mondloch at the Clearwater County History Center.

Farm By The Lake received \$6,000 to host thirteen concerts in June, July, and August, culminating in an *Annual Art Festival* with three additional musical performances.
