



Arts Grants Awarded in Hubbard County

Region 2 Arts Council (R2AC) awarded \$61,629 to arts organizations, schools, non-profits, and individual artists in Hubbard County in FY 2018.

Jeremy Simonson received a \$2,000 Individual Artist Grant to purchase a wide-angle lens and a printer to create photographic prints.

Ryan Stewart was awarded a \$1,654 Individual Artist Grant to purchase welding equipment and supplies to create metal art.

Northern Light Opera Company received a \$6,000 Arts Access Grant to produce the musical *My Fair Lady*.

Heartland Concert Association was awarded a \$4,000 per year Community Arts Support Grant for artist fees and publicity costs.

Nemeth Art Center was awarded a \$6,000 per year Community Arts Support Grant for compensation of the Executive Director.

Northern Light Opera Company was awarded a \$6,000 per year Community Arts Support Grant for general and administrative expenses and excess program expenditures

Park Rapids Lakes Area Arts Council was awarded a \$3,000 per year Community Arts Support Grant to incubate PRLAAC-sponsored projects

City of Park Rapids Arts and Culture Advisory Commission received \$6,000 Arts Access Grant to initiate a sculpture trail in the Red Bridge Park. Ribbon cutting is projected to be June 16, 2018.

Nemeth Art Center received a \$2,323 Arts Access Grant to host an exhibition called *White Earth Window*, a collaboration by photographer Wayne Gudmundson and writer Anton Treuer, which reflects the Anishinaabe experience on the White Earth Reservation, from May 31 - July 28, 2018.

Nemeth Art Center was awarded a \$2,007 Arts Access Grant to host the exhibition titled, *The Extraordinary Outdoors*, curated by Tim Peterson, featuring the work of five Minnesota artists whose works depict dynamic visual explorations into nature, August 3 – September 29, 2018. (

Park Rapids Downtown Business Association received a \$2,725 Arts Access Grant to provide free, live music with the 2nd Street Stage summer concert series. The ten events will be held on Thursday evenings from June 14 through Aug. 16, on the 2nd block of Main Avenue in Park Rapids.

Park Rapids Lakes Area Arts Council was awarded a \$4,915 Arts Access Grant to produce Art Leap 2018, a driving tour of artists' studios and other cultural destinations. September 22 & 23, 2018.

Joshua Schueller received a \$600 Young Artist Grant to take Violin lessons with Dr. Dina Neglia-Kahtchyan. (Hubbard County)

Zachary Schueller was awarded a \$600 Young Artist Grant to take Trumpet lessons with Paul Loxtercamp and Del Lyren.

Hubbard County Developmental Achievement Center received a \$1,305 Arts Project Grant to create a community-made Mosaic Mural with artist Marsha Wolff at the Hubbard County Developmental Achievement Center.

Nemeth Art Center was awarded a \$2,500 Arts Project Grant to host an exhibition of Julie Buffalohead's paintings and drawings, and Nathanael Flink's paintings and sculptures from May 3 through July 14.

Nemeth Art Center received a \$2,500 Arts Project Grant to host a sculptural installation exhibition by previous Bush Fellow, Alexa Horochowski.

Northern Light Opera Company was awarded a \$2,500 Arts Project Grant to host NLOKids Theater Project, which is a workshop and camp for children, from July 2 to July 20, 2018.

Park Rapids Lakes Area Arts Council received a \$2,500 Arts Project Grant to host the Great American Story, a storytelling competition, on September 22, 2018.

Park Rapids Schools were awarded a \$2,500 Arts Project Grant to host *A World of Music* with Todd Green, a seminar for middle and high school students, and a public performance, on September 25 & 27, 2018.
