



Arts Grants Awarded in Clearwater County

Region 2 Arts Council (R2AC) awarded \$19,411 to arts organizations, non-profits, and schools in Clearwater County in FY 2019.

Bagley Area Arts Collaborative received a \$4,764 Arts Access Grant for "Arts Unlimited," a series of art workshops for 2019.

Clearbrook-Gonvick Community Education received a \$796 Arts Access Grant to sponsor the play *Cinderella* for local performers age 7-adult as part of their Summer Recreation program.

Bagley Area Arts Collaborative received a \$1,236 Arts Access Grant to assist in hiring Creative Pear Designs to create a 7-page web site for publicizing arts events and promoting local artists.

Clear Waters Life Center received a \$6,000 Arts Learning Grant to provide 29 weeks of quality art classes for youth-older adults Jan-Aug 2019, 20 weeks of Monday classes offered in the afternoon and evening for adult learners and 9 weeks of youth after school classes on Wednesdays.

Bagley Area Arts Collaborative received a \$3,890 Arts Access for Small Towns Grant to hire local artist Maureen O'Brien to work with every student in grades 4, 5, and 6 at Bagley Elementary School to create a mural "We Are Each Unique and Beautiful, But Together We Are A Masterpiece."

Norda Gonvick Rosemalers received a \$1,383 Arts Project Grant to hire Trudy Peach, a gold medal rosemler, to teach the Os style of Norwegian rosemling.

Bagley Area Arts Collaborative received a \$1,342 Arts Project Grant to hire artist Kelli Lien to facilitate a three-day workshop teaching specific techniques used in creating a collage work of art with paper.
