Region 2 Arts Council awards Young Artist Grants

On March 9, 2020 a review panel consisting of community panelists and Region 2 Arts Council Board Members awarded \$4,200 through the Young Artist Grant program. This grant is designed for 8th -12th grade students who have a strong interest in the arts and reside in Beltrami, Clearwater, Hubbard, Lake of the Woods or Mahnommen counties. Students can apply for up to \$600 to cover costs associated with arts instruction/mentorship, arts classes/camps/workshops in the state of Minnesota.

Grant recipients included:

David Aguilera of Tenstrike was awarded \$600 to study woodworking with local woodworking artist, Tim Evje.

Josibeth Aguilera of Tenstrike was awarded \$600 to study mixed media painting techniques with visual artist Terry Honstead.

Noelle Aguilera of Tenstrike was awarded \$600 to study advanced Cavandoli Knotting techniques with fiber artist Karen Lisa Forbes.

D'Shel Bailey of Red Lake was awarded \$600 to study beadwork with a mentor artist.

John G. Kirk of Bemidji was awarded \$600 to study performance techniques for trombone with musician and music instructor, Ryan Webber.

Joza Paulson of Bemidji was awarded \$600 to attend a Bemidji Woodcarvers' workshop with Alec Lacasse, and mentor with woodcarver Les Sanders.

Timothy Pinkerton of Bemidji was awarded \$600 to study violin techniques for performance of Ysaÿe Sonata No. 2 for Solo Violin with Dr. Eric Olson.
