



## Arts Grants Awarded in Hubbard County

Region 2 Arts Council (R2AC) awarded \$43,292 to arts organizations, non-profits and individual artists in Hubbard County in FY 2021.

**The Nemeth Art Center** in Park Rapids was awarded \$6,000 to present internationally acclaimed, Minnesota-based photographer Alec Soth's *Paris, Minnesota* photo series and its accompanying educational engagement activities.

**The Hubbard County Developmental Achievement Center** in Park Rapids was awarded \$6,000 to hire 4 artists to provide visual art and theater classes to help participants to grow their artistic skills.

**The Hubbard County Developmental Achievement Center** in Park Rapids was awarded \$6,000 to hire a local artist to teach staff and participants how to use screen printing equipment.

**Heartland Arts** in Park Rapids was awarded \$5,900 to hire an artist to paint a mural in Pioneer Park in downtown Park Rapids.

**The Armory Arts & Events Center** in Park Rapids was awarded \$6,000 to support hiring a part-time Administrative Assistant.

**The Northern Light Opera Company** in Park Rapids was awarded \$5,892 to support the purchase of welding and lighting equipment to expand design possibilities into the future.

**Northern Light Opera Company** of Park Rapids was awarded \$3,000 to provide a 3-week children's theater camp, NLOKids, in collaboration with Pine Point School in Pine Point MN.

**Lowell Wolff** of Park Rapids was awarded \$1,500 to print, mount and frame 11 images as part of a large-scale photograph collection entitled "Reflections of Northern Minnesota."

Region 2 Arts Council awarded a total of **six \$500 Artist Relief grants** to support Hubbard County artists impacted by the COVID-19 pandemic.
