



## Arts Grants Awarded in Hubbard County

Region 2 Arts Council (R2AC) awarded \$71,511 to arts organizations, non-profits, institutions of higher learning, and individual artists in Hubbard County in FY 2022.

**Armory Arts & Events Center** was awarded \$6,000 in annual operating support through the 2-year Community Art Support Grant.

**Heartland Arts** was awarded \$5,000 in annual operating support through the 2-year Community Art Support Grant.

**Nemeth Art Center** was awarded \$6,000 in annual operating support through the 2-year Community Art Support Grant.

**Northern Light Opera Company** was awarded \$6,000 in annual operating support through the 2-year Community Art Support Grant.

**Heartland Arts** in Park Rapids was awarded a \$6,000 Arts Access Grant to organize Art Leap 2022, a driving tour to artists' studios and other local cultural destinations.

**The Northern Light Opera Company** in Park Rapids was awarded a \$5,111 Arts Access Grant to offer a 3-day "Making Film" Workshop led by award-winning film director David Leidy designed to facilitate a group of community-based filmmakers in the basics of making their own original films.

**The Northern Light Opera Company** in Park Rapids was awarded a \$6,000 Arts Access Grant to purchase lighting equipment and offer a Lighting Design Workshop, with award-winning lighting designer Heidi Eckwall, to area youth and theater lighting technicians.

**The Heartland Concert Association** in Park Rapids was awarded a \$2,120 Arts Access Grant to host Copper Street Brass, a Minneapolis-based brass sextet program, for students in the Park Rapids area.

**Northern Light Opera Company** in Park Rapids was awarded a \$6,000 Arts Access Grant to host the Workbench New Play Workshop, a 7-day workshop led by a duo of professional playwrights, to teach a group of community-based writers to create their own original plays.

**The Hubbard County Developmental Achievement Center** in Park Rapids was awarded a \$6,000 Arts Access Grant to help participants to increase their skills in papermaking, pottery and theater by learning and exploring new techniques, and developing deeper relationships with teaching artists.

**Northern Light Opera Company** in Park Rapids was awarded a \$6,000 Arts Learning Grant to provide a 3-week theater camp, NLOKids, for children to create an original play with music in collaboration with Pine Point and Park Rapids communities.

**Laporte School** was awarded a \$5,532 Arts Learning Grant to assist Laporte School to host an artist residency with musician, Ross Sutter, to assist students in grades 3- 5 in building two musical instruments, a mouth bow and a dulcimer.

**City of Park Rapids** was awarded a \$1,918 Arts Project Grant to work with the Culture Advisory Commission to update the city's Arts and Culture Plan.

**Diamond Knispel** of Laporte was awarded a \$1,830 Individual Artist Grant to assist in the travel and shipping expenses for exhibition of her latest body of work, "Wild Whimsy of the Northwoods."

**Joan Kauppi** of Park Rapids was awarded \$2,000 to further her skills and purchase framing materials for an exhibition of her collages at Watermark Art Center.
