Welcome to the Artists Engage Community Grant Review Panel.

Please score the grant applications assigned to you by considering the questions for each criteria/section - Artist Qualifications & Artistic Vision for the Project, Arts Access Provided by the Project, Community Impact and Evaluation of the Project, and Ability to Carry Out the Project. Score each criteria/section from 1-5 (1 = Not at All, 5 = Absolutely) or choose N/A if you have a conflict of interest and are abstaining. We also offer Budget Guidelines for applicants that can be useful when you are reading budgets. They describe what expenses are allowable and explain what we are looking for in different categories such as Travel, Equipment, or Administrative Expenses. If you have any problems or questions, contact the Grant Manager for help.

Many panelists prefer to score as they read because it gives them more time to be thoughtful and to write comments for the applicants. Make sure to save your scores and comments by scrolling to the end of the evaluation form and clicking the save button. Other panelists prefer to read applications ahead of time, but score them when we come together as a panel for faceto-face discussion. You may find your assessment changes as other panel members share their insights. Don't worry if you scored ahead of time, there will be time set aside to change your scores if you wish.

Please do not feel pressured to fill out all of them for each grant application.
